Bob Hille, a Certified Senior Crime Scene Analyst, has over 35 years of law enforcement experience with the last 24 years as a Senior Crime Scene Analyst for the Lakewood Police Department. Prior to his service in Lakewood, he was a Deputy Sheriff in Wisconsin. He is a court-qualified expert in Crime Scene Analysis and Bloodstain Pattern Analysis. Bob is a past President of the Rocky Mountain Division of the International Association for Identification as well as the Rocky Mountain Association of Bloodstain Pattern Analysts.

Course Description:

This course is intended as an entry-level class in Crime Scene Investigations. Topics covered include police photography, latent print processing, evidence documentation and collection, introduction to bloodstain pattern analysis and death investigation and video and computer evidence. DNA collection and new law regarding buccal swabbing will be covered. Attendees are expected to bring the camera they would be using in the field for practical exercises. Casual attire as some practical exercises can be messy. This is a three-day course with hands on activity. Class size is limited.
