Course Description: *Learn how to determine if someone has been sexually abused, how the victim reveals the perpetrator and also if someone is likely to be a perpetrator. Students will be able to look at handwriting and instantly know if the writer has been sexually abused and, if so, the gender of the perpetrator. Additionally the student will learn the best way to gain more written information (such as room it occurred, perpetrators name, etc.) without directly asking the individual. Obtaining information this way – via handwriting - will prevent the probable re-victimization of the individual. Included are visual and descriptive checklists of handwritten “red flags” that are seen in both sexual abuse victims and sexual offenders handwriting (print or cursive).*
