At the completion of **IRSPLE** training students will be able to perform all the behavioral objectives of the course. Students will be able to gather information, ask informal and formal questions to a Spanish speaker, arrest and control a dangerous contact, be aware when a plot to the officer's safety arises, and be culturally aware of the intrinsic behavior characteristics of a Latino.

Every topic is a small part of the big picture. Example: Arrest and Control. Day 1. the student learns to identify only the body parts pertinent to the arrest and control of a subject. Day 2. builds on the first sequence by adding behavioral commands to the body parts they have learned previously. Day 3 introduces the parts of a vehicle. As the vocabulary escalates, review and repetition become easier and more familiar. Use of "practical exercises," the student, without reading, can execute a felony car stop and/or high risk entrance, as the same vocabulary is utilized. Any word or phrasing that continues to give the student problems can be eradicated soon after because of the fact that they have repeated many times to that point, the correct pronunciation is at the tip of their tongue, and they have the handout reference to visualize and practice from.
