- Students will understand how their body is related directly to their brain and handwriting.
- Students will learn how printers and cursive writers vary in thoughts, emotions, and behavior patterns.
- Students will learn how to analyze the thoughts and behavior style of all universal languages even if there is no comprehensive of the ability.
- Students will understand how to build a "Gestalt" personality profile of the writer
