Topics include "Lawful Prescribing and Prevention of Diversion," "Abuse and Diversion of Controlled Substances," major case investigations (the investigation of criminal prescribers), pharmacy scams, scams against physicians, and programs for law enforcement on pain, physical dependence, and addiction.

These cards are extremely beneficial to officers who encounter pharmaceuticals on the street and want a quick and easy reference to identify them.
