Course Description: This class teaches students how to uncover the truth when hidden in written words. It will reveal lies by the way the words are written (spacing, slant, pressure, baseline, individual letter characteristics such as the "alfalfa o", and more). This is not the same as content analysis. The student will be able to learn which phrases to have the suspect or person of interest write in order to obtain the most information and solve the case more quickly. By having all suspects write specific statements (that the student will learn in class) you will be able to find out who is withholding information and who most likely committed the crime. Also the student will learn to take victim statements and pull out lies as well! REAL SAMPLES / CASES are used for "hands on" time. The student will learn how the writer gives other valuable clues to the crime such as place where it occurred, other people that may know something about the case, and even intended victims. This is invaluable for the victim, witness and perpetrator statements. With the skills learned in this class you will never a lie again!
